

Michael's Intensive Supported Housing Accord (MISHA) project is an innovative homeless program funded by a private donor that provides men experiencing homelessness in the Parramatta area of Sydney with immediate access to long-term, stable accommodation while supporting them to build the lives they would like to live.

A safe place to stay

None of the men spent any time sleeping rough over the last year.

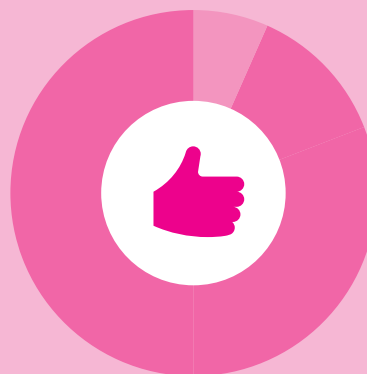
